- ★ 70% of the women seeking our services are in distress, crisis or transition.
- ★ 75% of women using our confidential services are living at or below the poverty level.
- ★ Women of all ages attend our programs.
- ★ Referral sources include government agencies, churches and other non-profits, including Community Health Care, Tacoma Community House and YWCA Pierce County.
- ★ Since 2007, we have offered Pierce County's only ongoing domestic violence prevention support group in Spanish.
